

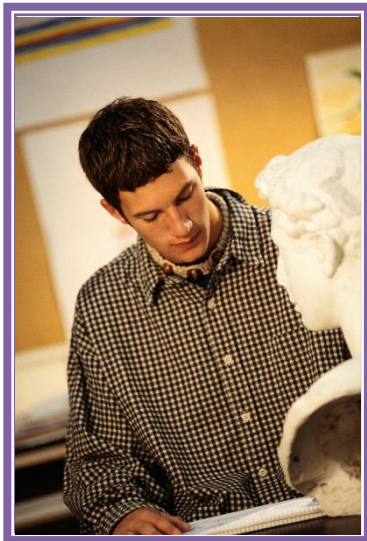
Wisconsin Campus Compact Rural Service Learning Summit November 9 – 11, 2011
