VENTURE GRANT BRIEF PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The brief project description sample below accompanied a fully funded Venture Grant proposal.

In partnership with the Friends of the Rouge (FOTR), geography students will participate in four activities for water quality analysis. Specifically, students will take part in the FOTR fall and spring bug hunts, January stone fly search and the annual frog and toad survey in the Bell Branch Subwatershed of the Rouge River.

Additionally, students will perform biannual water quality tests. All data will be shared with FOTR and the City of Livonia, Michigan.
